## **BCBSKS requests client data to complete RxDC reporting**

*Deadline to respond is April 23*

Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas (BCBSKS) mailed letters last week to group contacts requesting data needed to comply with Prescription Drug Data Collection (RxDC) reporting. The Consolidated Appropriations Act (CAA) requires insurance companies and employer-based plans to submit information regarding prescription and health care spending to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) by June 1 of each year.

The BCBSKS [letter](#) provides step-by-step instructions on how to submit the requested data through the carrier's online portal. Login and PIN requirements are unique to each group and can be found on page two of the letter. The deadline to respond is April 23. Employers who don't provide the necessary data on time will be required to file directly with CMS. Failure to complete the reporting requirement could result in a CMS penalty of \$100 per day per affected individual.
